

2018–2019 SELF GRADUATE FELLOWSHIP PROFILE

The Madison and Lila Self Graduate Fellowship offers a special opportunity for students seeking a Ph.D. at the University of Kansas. The fellowship seeks students with attributes that will put them on track to make a difference in the world and in their professions.

Self Graduate Fellows for 2018–2019 will receive \$30,500 each year for four years. Payment is through appointment as a graduate research assistant. The fellowship covers tuition, fees, and the employer’s share of student health insurance costs. Over the four years, fellows have access to a \$5,500 professional development award. All fellows also participate in the Fellow Development Program. The total value of the four-year doctoral fellowship exceeds \$175,000.

The Fellow Development Program is a distinctive feature of the fellowship. It provides education and training in communication, management, innovation, and leadership to assist fellows in their preparation for future leadership roles; complementing the specialized education and training provided in Ph.D. programs.

This year 38 fellows are pursuing 18 Ph.D.s in five schools at the University of Kansas. The current fellows are among 188 students who have benefited from the fellowship since it was established in 1989.
